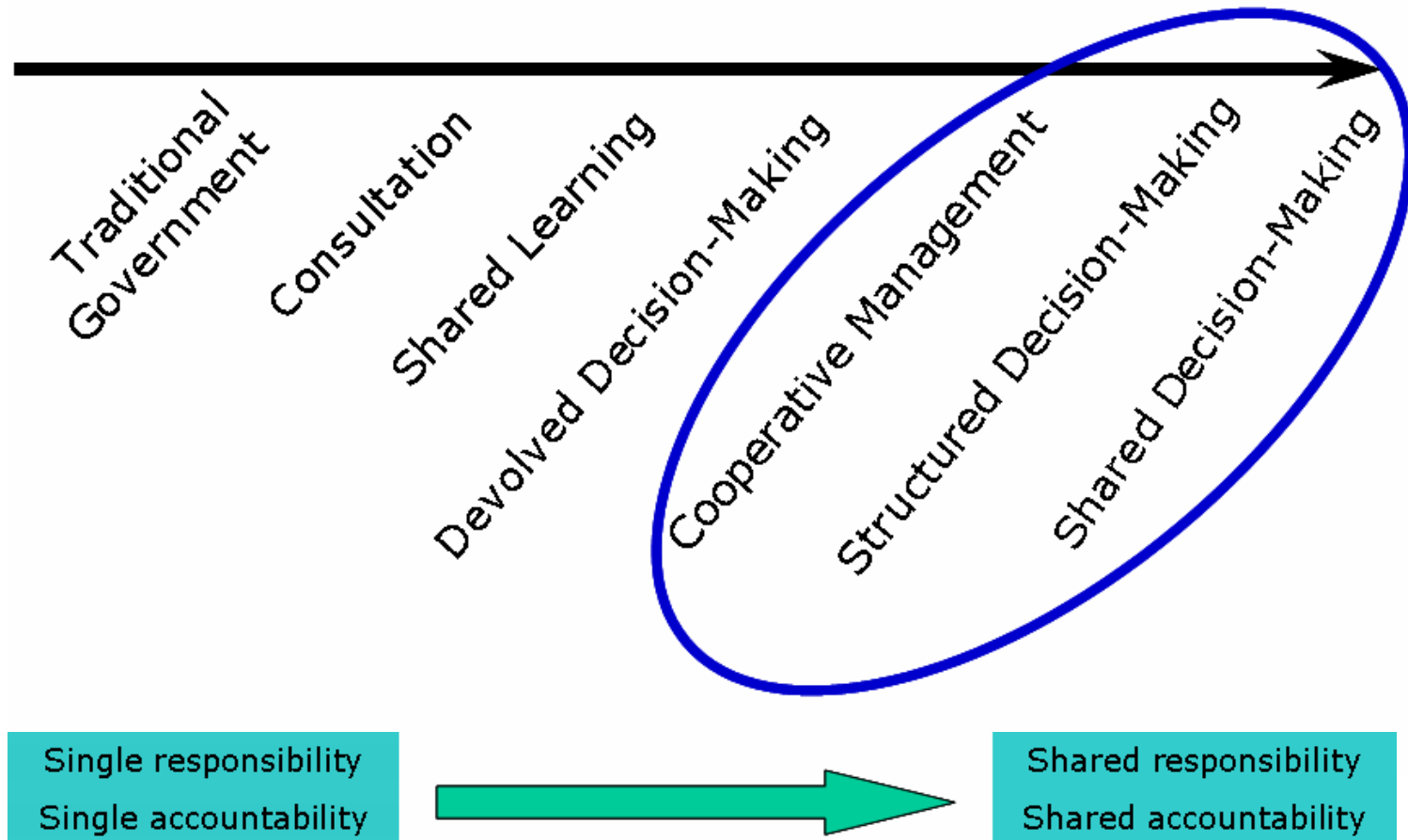

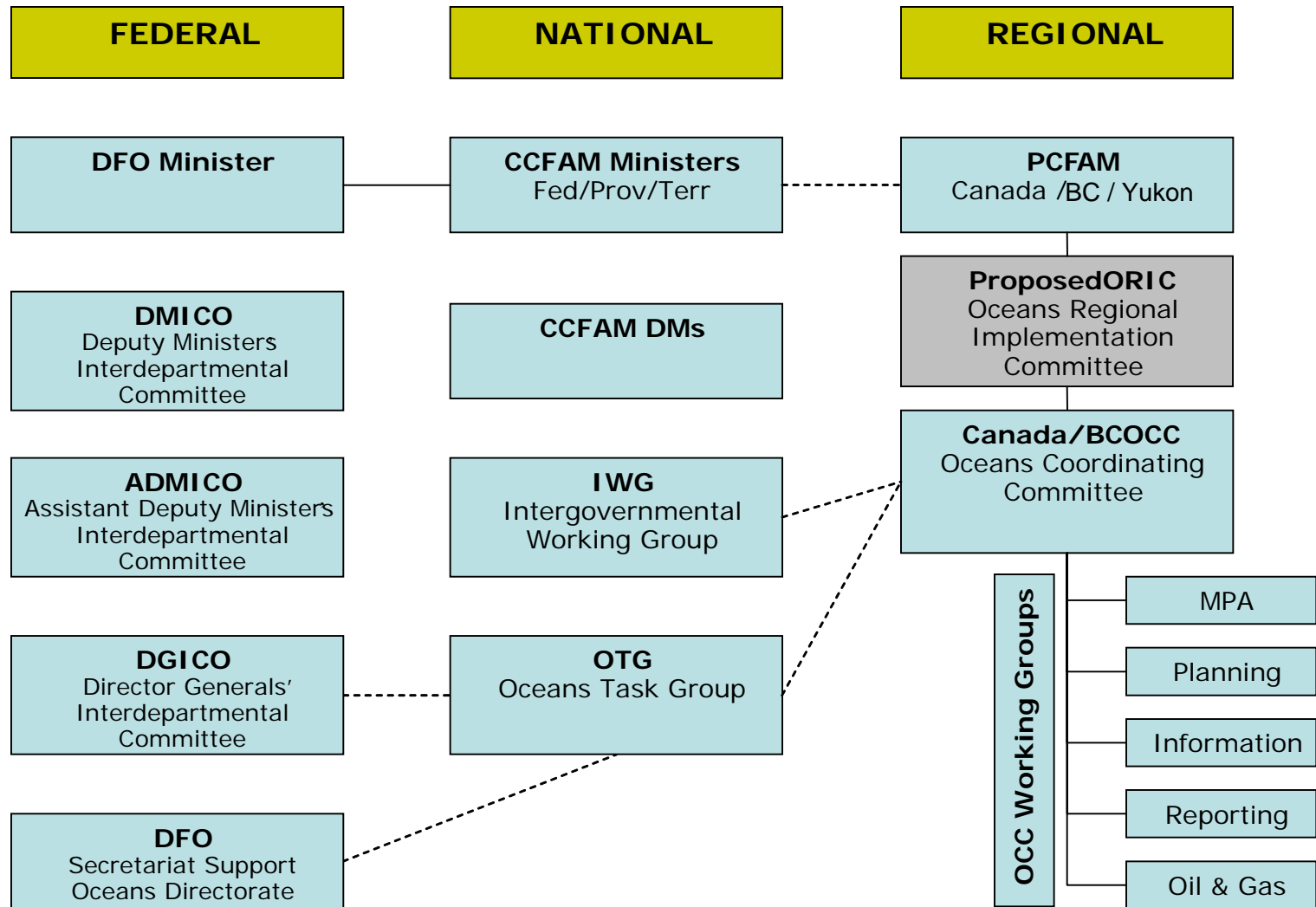

Continuum of Governance Arrangements

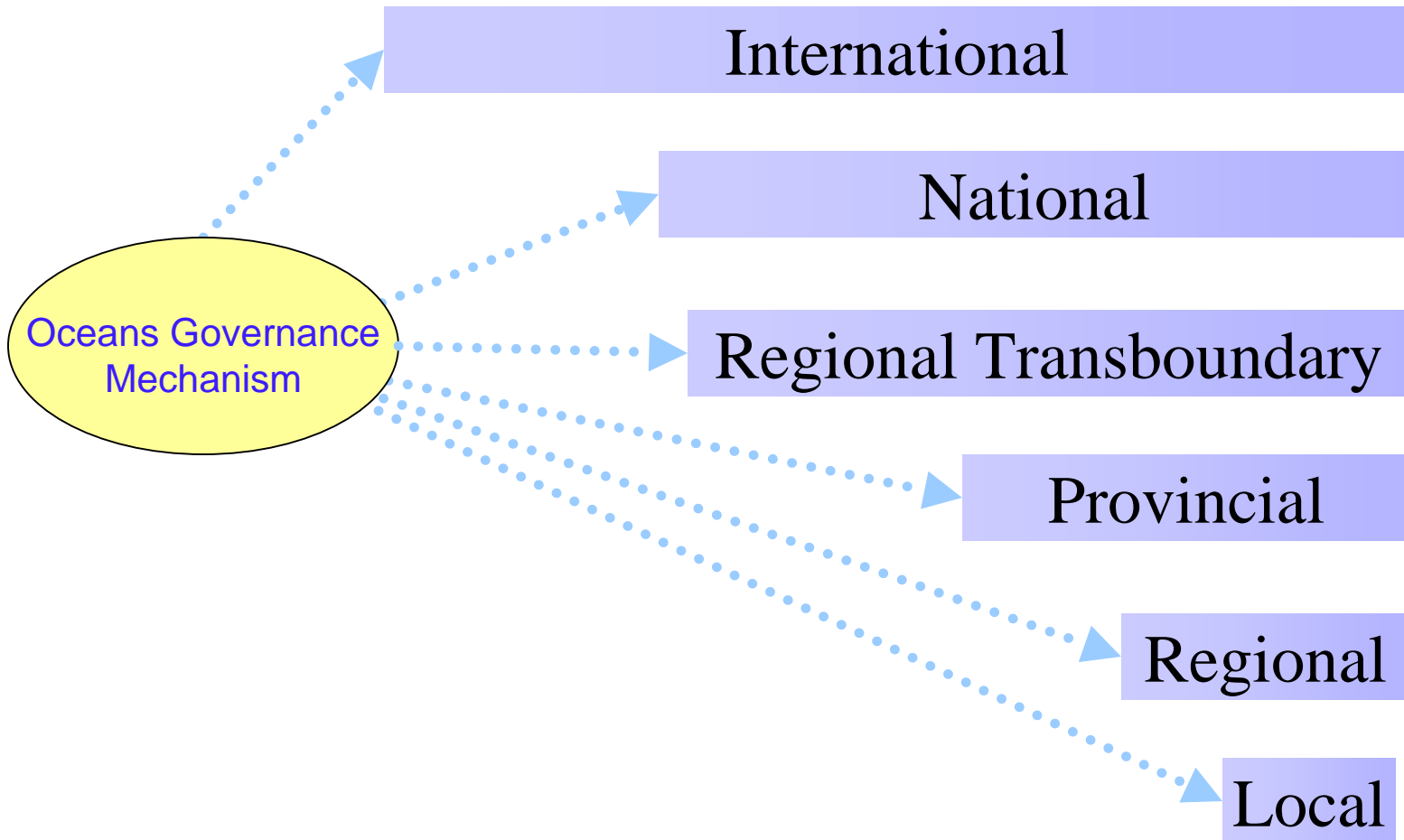


Oceans Governance Relationships



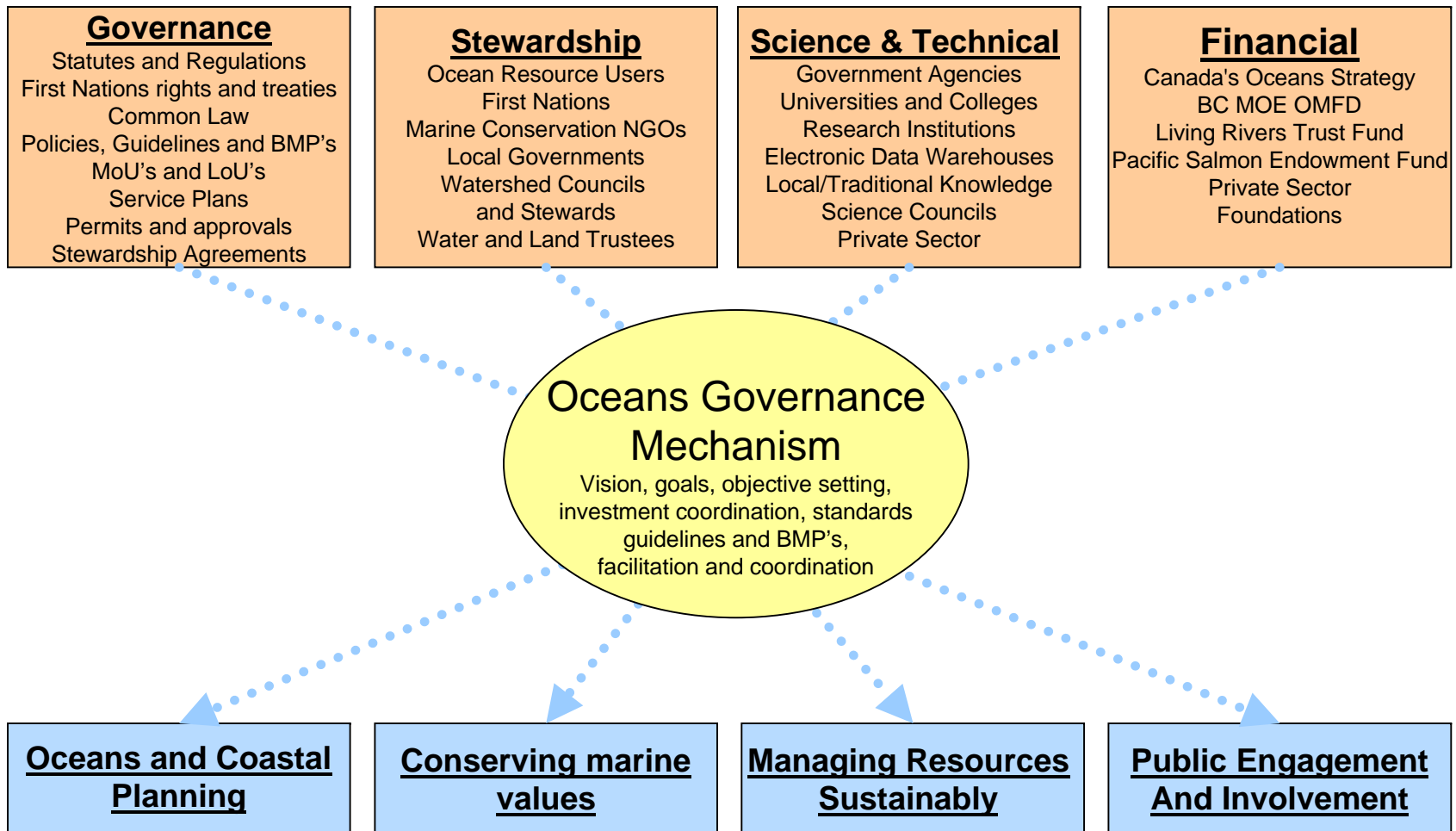
Spatial Scales of Governance

A Proposed Oceans Governance Model

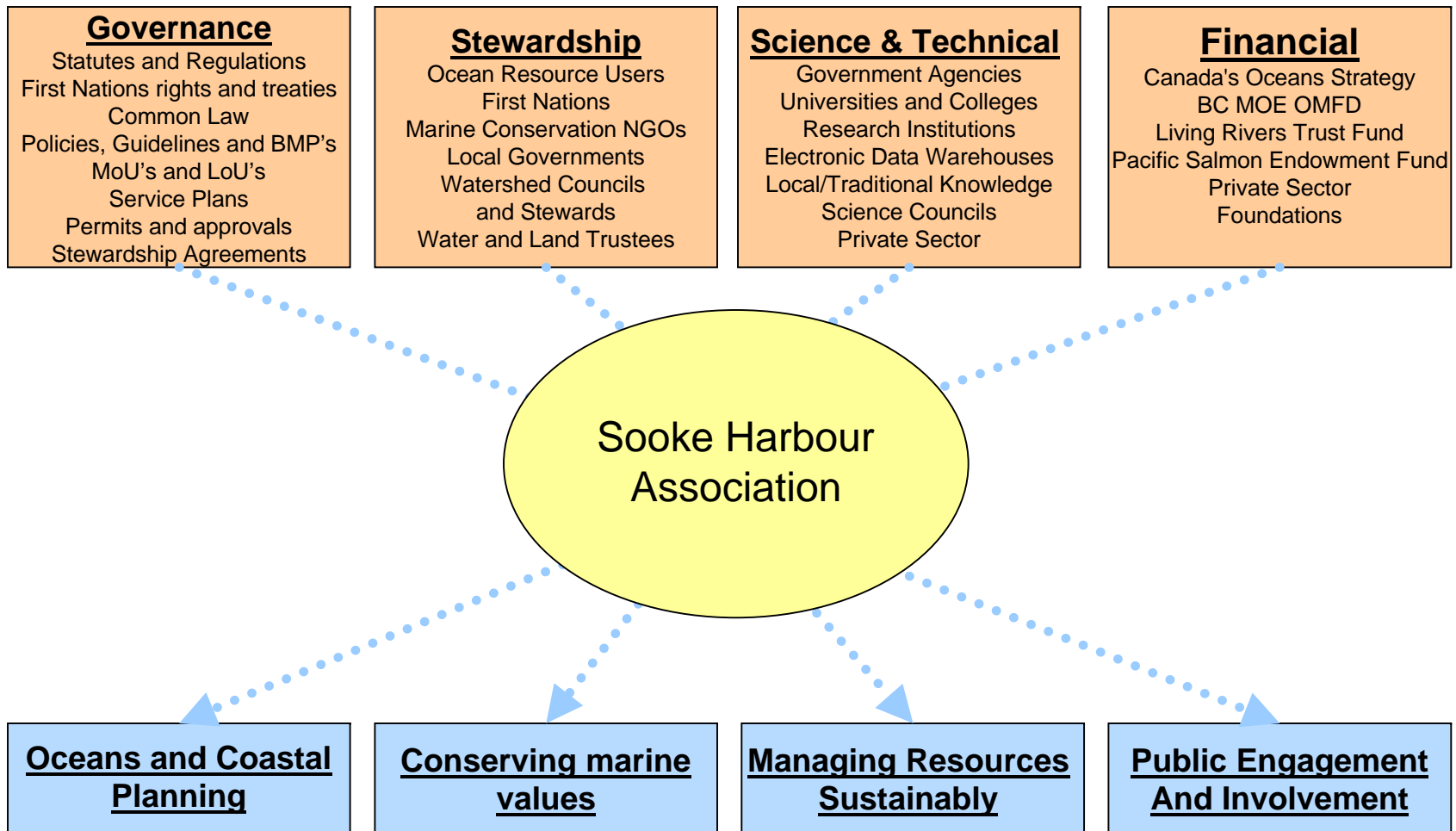

Local Oceans Governance Model

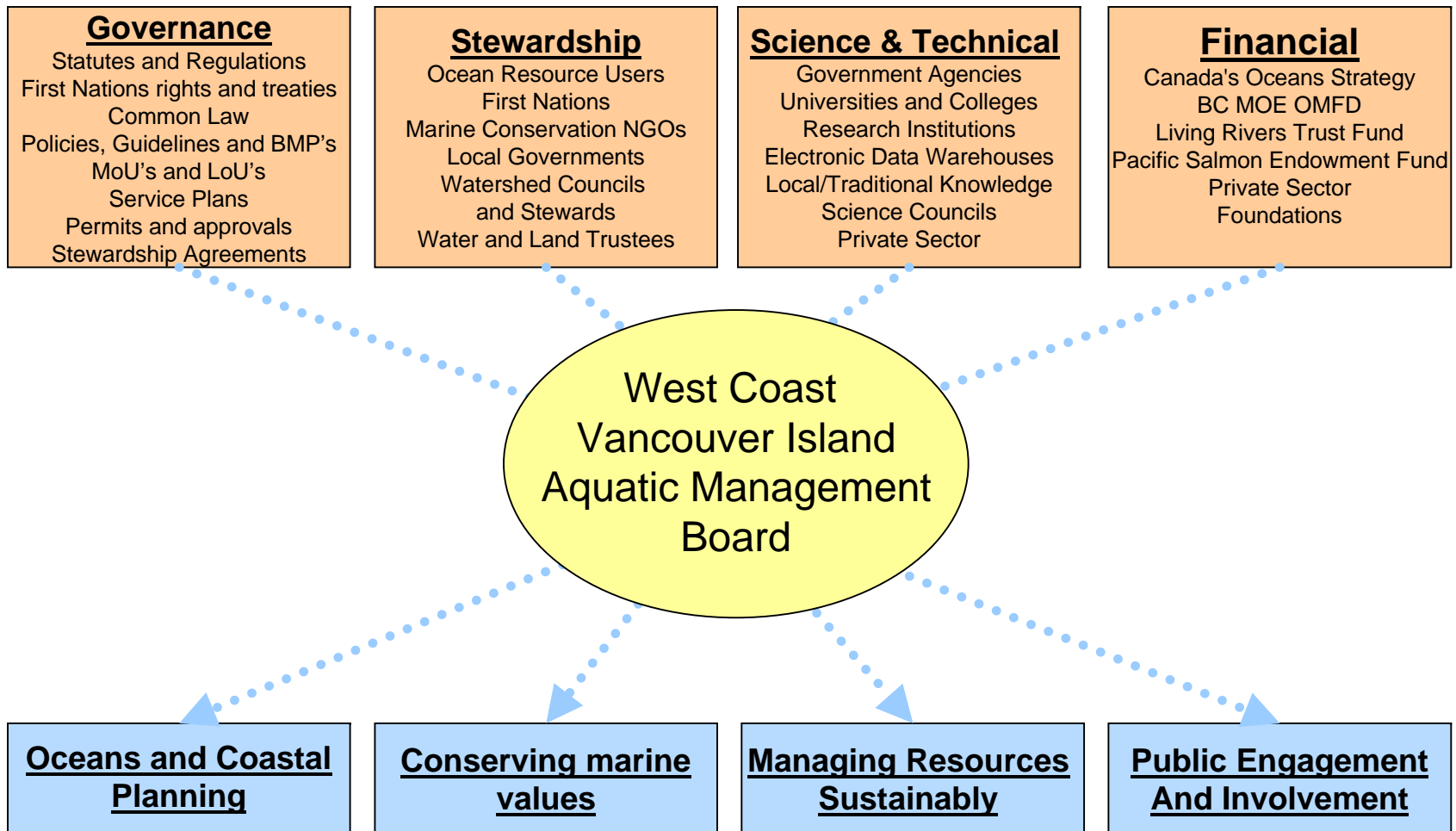

Regional Oceans Governance Model

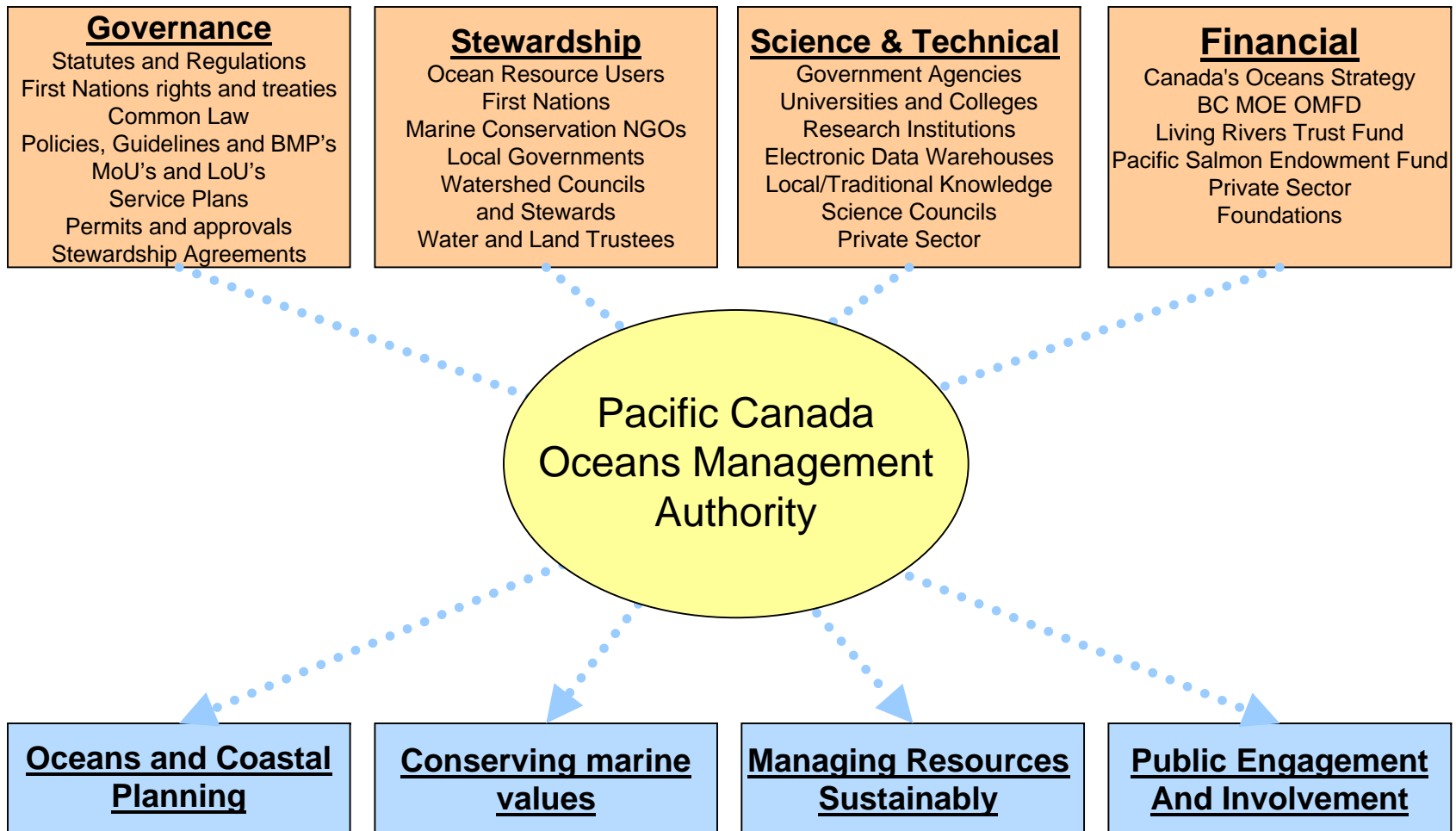

Provincial Oceans Governance Model

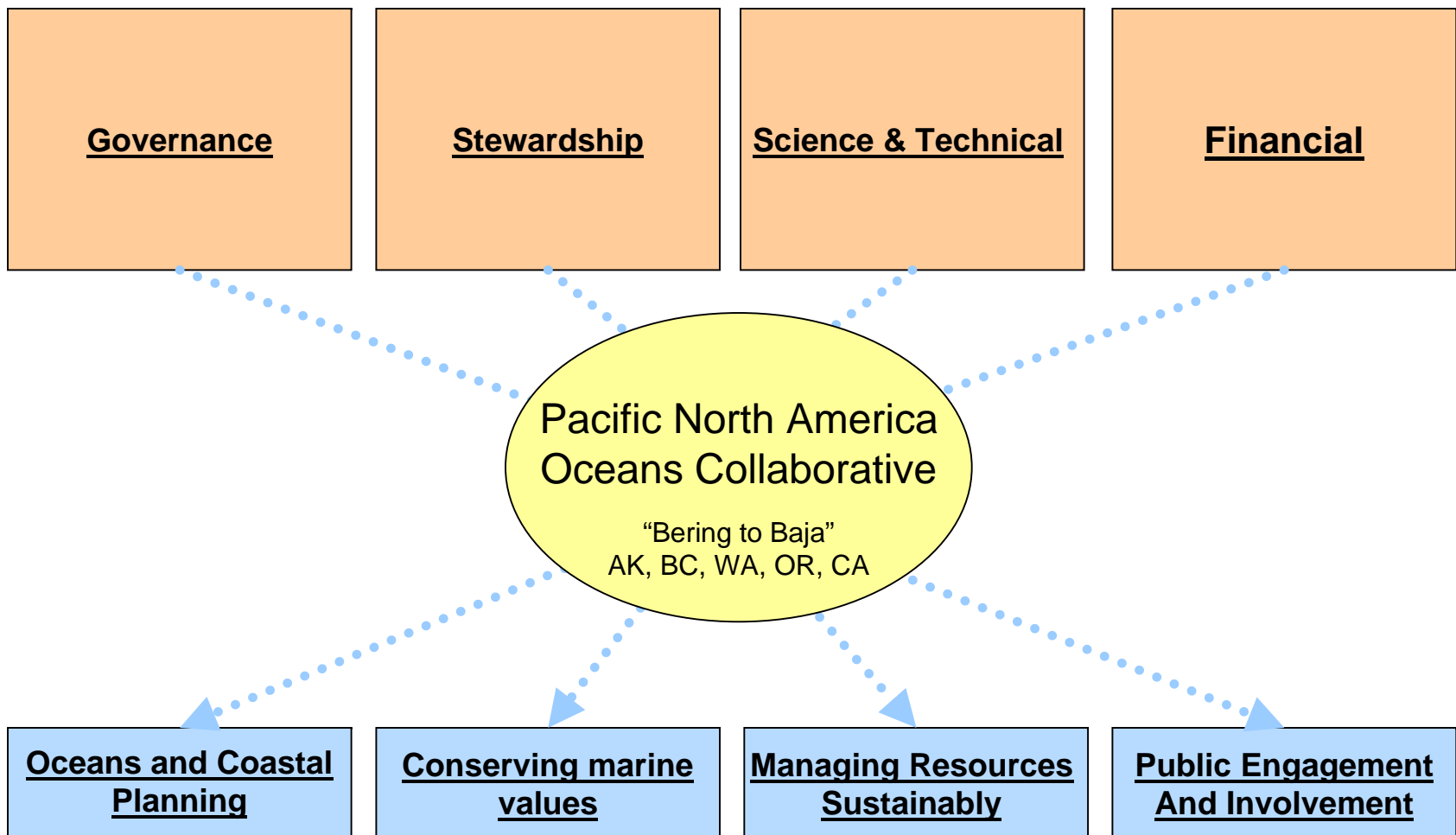

Regional Transboundary Oceans Governance Model

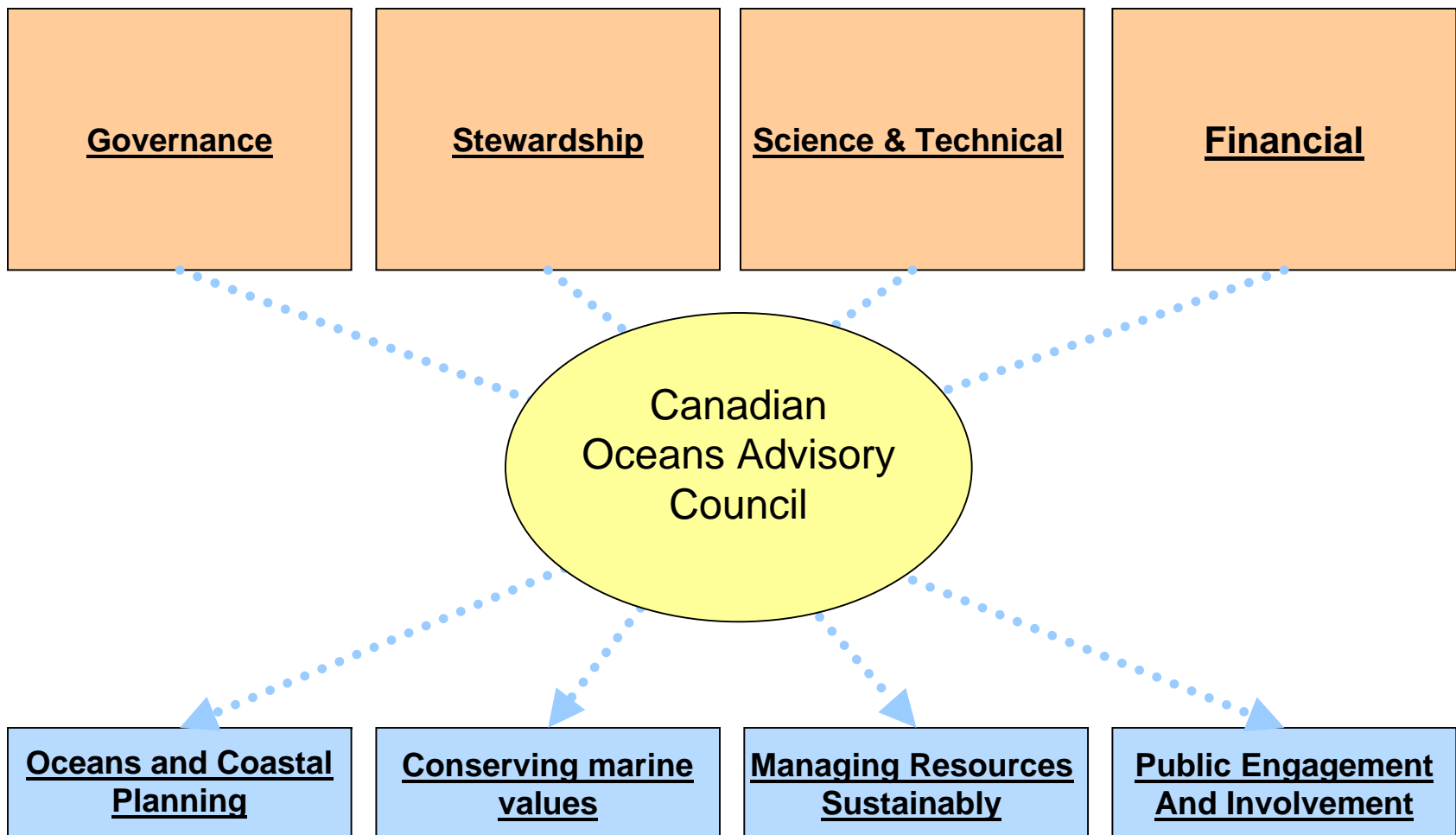
