MASC funds graduate scholarships at the University of Victoria and three other Canadian universities that support research and writing across the broad field of ocean studies. MASC aims to offer more and better-funded scholarships in order to support further research in this vital field.

MASC also organizes public forums and workshops on Canadian maritime concerns. Most recently, MASC organized and managed a meeting of experts on the Canadian Arctic for Foreign Affairs Canada.

The MASC President's Club was established in 2005 to provide additional support for MASC's scholarships. Members of the President's Club come from all walks of life, but each joined in order to support research in ocean studies, an area of vital concern to Canadians.

What the President's Club Supports

MASC awards annual scholarships between \$5,000 and \$10,000. MASC has supported a wide range of dissertation and theses including: coastal zone natural resource management; improved global positioning systems for maritime navigation; and fisheries conservation and enforcement.
